## **Bay Area Mobility Management (BAMM) 2016 Scholarship Application**

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Because of the volume of applications received, please follow these instructions very carefully, particularly the instructions for assembling your packet for submission. Only those applications that comply with these instructions will be qualified for consideration by the selection committee.

ANY APPLICATION THAT DOES NOT INCLUDE ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION WILL BE DISQUALIFIED UNLESS ALL DOCUMENTS ARE **RECEIVED** BY THE PHILANTHROPY DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN THE END OF THE DAY ON WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2016.

The scholarships will be awarded at a mid year meeting in 2016. (MEETING PLACE TO BE DETERMINED)

Bay Area Mobility Management is a non-profit organization that brings together corporations and relocation service providers in and around the San Francisco Bay Area for the primary purpose of providing educational information and current industry updates to its members. As part of our commitment to Relocation, BAMM has developed a scholarship program for current high school seniors who have relocated into the San Francisco Bay Area sometime between grades 9 (after 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation) and 12. **The one-time awards of \$1000 each will be presented to at least one San Francisco Bay Area public high school senior this year.** Two scholarships were awarded in 2015. The award will be sent to the college that the student will be attending to assist with tuition, etc.

The BAMM will select scholarship winners based on the strength of their total package. The student will be evaluated on academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and on their response to an essay addressing the challenges associated with relocating to a new area and a new high school. If you are willing to read your scholarship at one of our quarterly meetings(although this is not mandatory) but it will also be weighted as part of the evaluation process.

### ***APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS***

- Currently a senior in good standing in a San Francisco Bay Area public high school(signature of school official required).
- Relocated between grades 9 and 12.
- Relocated more than 50 miles and changed schools due to their family's relocation
- Provide SAT/ACT scores(documented)
- Currently have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 (or equivalent achievement on a different scale)

**Please submit the following information along with your completed application to your Guidance Department.**



**PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL DOCUMENTS INCLUDING APPLICATION, SAT SCORES AND ESSAYS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE SAME TIME.**

- 1) **LIST** (on a separate sheet) all of your extra-curricular activities and work experience during high school (after 8<sup>th</sup> grade).
- 2) **PERSONAL ESSAY:** Compose a thoughtful “personal essay” (double-spaced, 1,000 to 1,500 words) that will help the Scholarship Selection Committee members learn about your personal history, perspectives, personal and career goals, interest, financial need and education plans. Most importantly, tell us about your challenges and experiences encountered while relocating to your new home and high school as well as any successes achieved. We would also appreciate any advice you would give to another teenager preparing to relocate (as you did)! *This is a very important part of the application because it helps the Scholarship Selection Committee members get a sense of who you are and how your relocation journey influenced and how you used that to make the move easier on you and your family.* The essay must be emailed in a Word (or pdf) Document format. This is very important as we will publish your documents on our website at [www.mybamm.org](http://www.mybamm.org). Bay Area Mobility Management. In addition the winners will be asked to join us at one of our meetings in 2015.
- 3) In addition, *your extra-curricular activities* are important as well as your community work. Don't forget that component is a part of this Scholarship Program also.
